



Medical Termination of Pregnancy – Fees Explained

This information sheet has been developed to provide patients with information regarding the fees involved in having a medical termination of pregnancy at Pivotal Health Family Planning.

We have an overall **out of pocket expense** of \$300 which is payable at the completion of your first appointment with Dr Marsden. This amount is refundable should you decide not to continue with the procedure. We offer a concession fee of \$260 for patients who hold a current commonwealth government Health Care Card or Pension card.

The initial visit is a total of \$417.40 (\$377.40 for concession card holders); you will receive \$117.40 back from Medicare. Once the initial out-of-pocket expense has been paid, all appointments relating to 'Medical Termination of Pregnancy' are bulk billed. It is anticipated that you will require a minimum of two or three visits.

There is a cost for the medication (MS2Step - Mifepristone, misoprostol) will be available at your appointment (no need to collect from a pharmacy). The cost of this medication is approximately \$41 or \$7.30 for concession card holders.

It is recommended that you use pain relief and anti-nausea medication at various times through your treatment. The doctor will discuss this with you at your appointment. There may be a small charge of approximately \$7 should the doctor give you anti nausea medication at your appointment.

It is important to note that should the medical termination of pregnancy be unsuccessful and a surgical termination is required that the cost of this procedure would be at your own expense, the cost ranges between \$450 and \$500 depending on the clinic. For more information regarding this, please read the procedure information the doctor will supply to you at your appointment.

It is important to bring your current Medicare card and/or concession card with you to your appointment.
